> MyChoice HSA: Spend, Save, Invest

HSA members have options for their funds

Some members choose to **SPEND** them on day-to-day medical costs, such as glasses, lab fees, prescriptions, OTC remedies, etc.

Other members may choose to take the long-term benefits of an HSA into account and set funds aside for growth.

The **SAVE** option in the MyChoice HSA allows members to set aside funds into a money market fund and realize a 3-6% dividend rate. (subject to change based on interest rates. Stable and low-risk option.

Finally, all members also have the **INVEST** option, in which they can purchase from our line up of ETFs in the self-directed investment model.

Both the save and invest features are optional, and members may liquidate these funds at any time to return funds to their spend (cash) account.









Informational modal to help members get an overview of their options.








> Initiate Investment Options

Accounts > HSA

Member has reached \$1,000 (or client-determined) threshold to begin investing.

Any member who has not yet initiated investment options (either the Save or Invest), will be required to submit a one-time investment questionnaire to open their account.

No change in this process. This is how members currently start investing.










Member selects Save

Member views more information about the fee, the money market fund, and sets their initial Save goal.




Member selects Save

Member has reached \$1,000 (or client-determined) threshold to begin investing.

Member makes initial goal and selects an amount from the Spend (cash) category to fund the Save category.

Member has the option to set up an Auto Sweep to "set it and forget it" and allow incoming dividends and contributions to automatically move into their Save category.






> Member selects Save

Select Save and receive confirmation.








Edit Save Goal

Accounts > HSA

Members may edit their goals at any time.






> Edit Invest Goal

Member has reached \$1,000 (or client-determined) threshold to begin investing.

Members may edit their goals at any time.




Manage Auto Sweep

Member has reached \$1,000 (or client-determined) threshold to begin investing.

Members may manage their auto sweep at any time.

This screen walks the member through setting up the auto-sweep when they have BOTH the Save and Invest categories.

Members set the threshold they want to keep in their Spend category and set their maximum amounts for Save and/or Invest.





> Transfer Funds


Accounts > HSA

Member has funds in any of the three categories.

They may transfer funds from **Spend to** [bank account] to reimburse themselves for an out of pocket payment for an eligible medical expense.

They may transfer funds from their **Save** account to their **Spend Account.** (this process can take 2-3 business days to move funds)

To liquidate investment funds, members will go through the current process to sell investments and determine the amount from each fund.









> Possible Progress Bars

Examples of member with Save and Invest categories activated.




These are different views of what the dashboard and HSA account page progress bars could look like, depending on the member's goals and usage.
